Lilac City Studio is pleased to present *North*, a solo exhibition of Anastasia Klose's recent drawings since moving to far north Queensland, Kuku Yalandji Country in late 2019. Klose's drawing practice is inspired by the animals and landscape around her.

Anastasia Klose was born in Melbourne in 1978. She studied Fine Art majoring in drawing at the VCA. Previously she completed a Bachelor of Arts at Melbourne University. She initially became known in the 2000s for her autobiographical video, performance and installation works. Since then, she has developed a drawing practice. Humour, animals and her curiousity about life beyond what is immediately visible are her usual subjects. Always a stinge/unemployed she thinks dirt, fluff, dog hair and heavily marked paper endlessly recycled into new drawings adds to the talismanic charge of each drawing. Currently she is showing in *Know my Name* at the National Gallery Canberra and *PINK* at Wyndham Art Gallery Melbourne. She lives in Mossman Gorge, Far North Queensland.
